Queen's Drive Walk

Distance ➤ 4 km (2.5 miles)
Time ➤ 90 minutes
Grade ➤ moderate




This walk follows part of a favourite carriage drive used by Queen Victoria.

From the centre of the village follow the A93 road south towards Glen Shee for about 1km, then turn left following the sign to 'the Queen's Drive and Lion's Face'.

Follow this track for about 1.2km, through scattered Birch woodland with good views over the Clunie Water, pass a conifer woodland and lochan on the left (Corrie Feragie).

Turn left at the sign marked "Braemar", to return through a plantation to rejoin the main path leading back down to the village.
