STRATHDON WALK 02

Forbestown Circular

Distance ► 4 km (2 miles) Time ► 60 minutes Crade ► moderate





A forest walk through the Bellabeg Plantation in the Forest of Newe with an excellent view back across Bellabeg and Upper Donside.

Starting from the car park and toilets near the Memorial close to the village, turn right back into the village. Pass the village store, (after stocking up with snacks and drinks) after 500m turn left at the small post box into the forest and pick up the forest track.

Turn left now and proceed gradually uphill towards the mast. Take time on this section to look back across the dispersed rural community of Upper Donside. Follow the markers across the hill before heading back downhill to join the main road next to the post box. Take care as you retrace your steps back to the car.
